About this listing:

Though errors have surely been made, every care has been taken to be as accurate as possible in recording the names, dates, and personal messages on the grave markers in Rock Spring Cemetery. Many markers are missing or out of place, and some are worn and illegible. Whenever markings are unclear, it is noted and a question mark is added. Some graves are not marked; we will likely never know where all graves and vacancies are. Finding contact persons among property owners remains a priority.

Numbers assigned to cemetery family plots have been placed arbitrarily to provide reference points, beginning with the SW corner of the cemetery, #1, moving down the church line to the SE corner, #16, then up and down, ending at the NW corner, #85. Since most family plots contain several last names, the other names are listed alphabetically as well as under name of family plot where buried; hence, many are listed twice. The 2<sup>nd</sup> listing is noted by (2<sup>nd</sup>).

It is our hope that this roster will be expanded into a more thorough history of our cemetery to include as much family and personal data as can be gathered. We have enjoyed gathering this data and feel great reverence for our cemetery.
